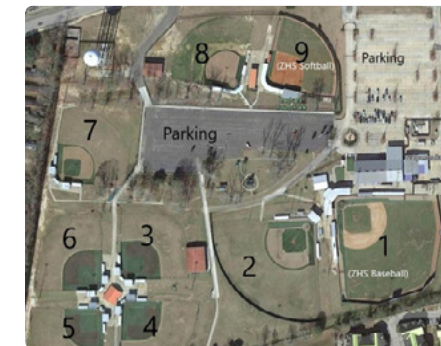

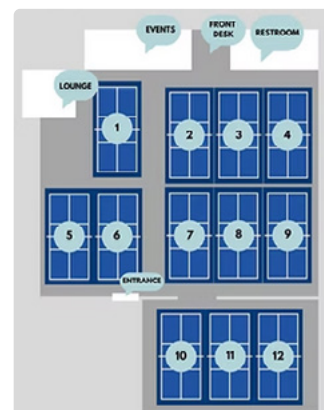
ELITE AT A GLANCE

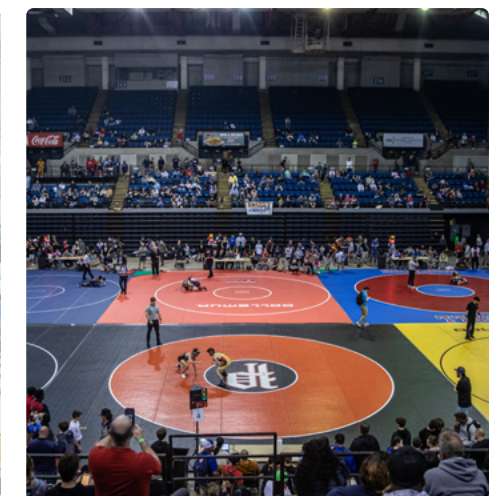
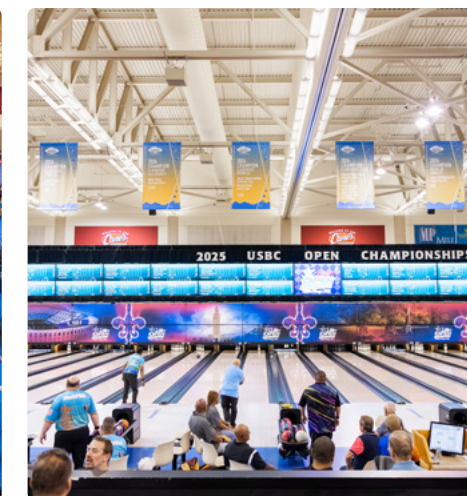


RIVER CENTER

PROUDLY MANAGED BY LEGENDS GLOBAL

Located in downtown Baton Rouge along the banks of the Mississippi River, the Raising Cane's River Center has transformed the downtown area. The entire complex, including the Arena and Theatre for the Performing Arts, as well as the Exhibition Hall, includes more than 200,000 square feet of space. The center also incorporates state-of-the-art exhibition, meeting rooms, and kitchen facilities.

The 70,000 square-foot Exhibition Hall can be combined with the existing Arena to create more than 100,000 square-feet of contiguous exhibit space.

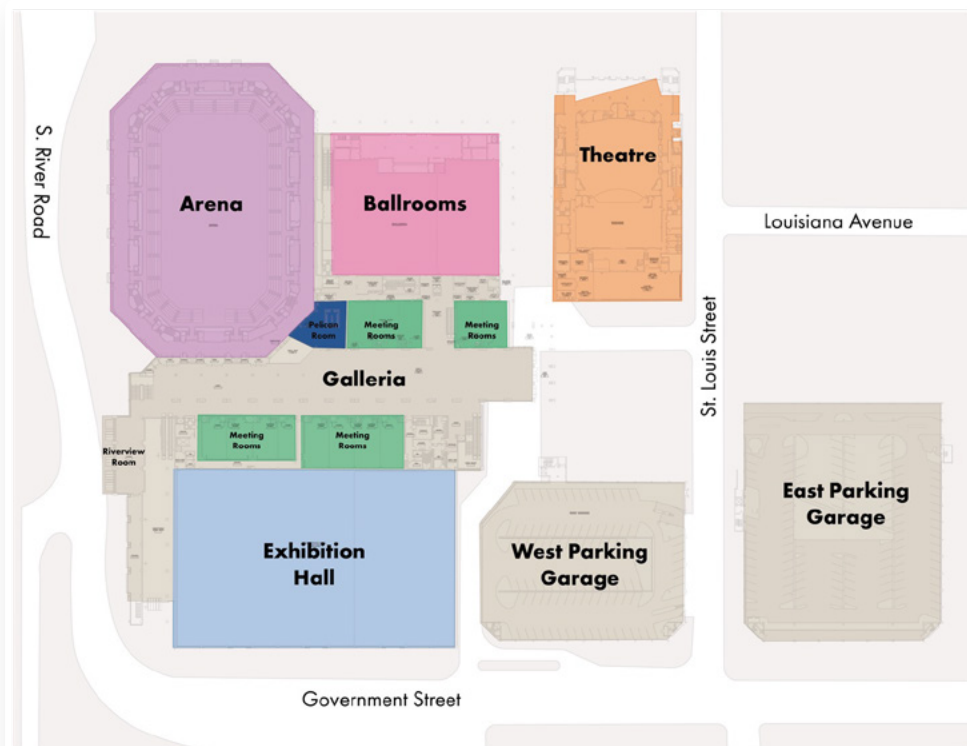


SITE OVERVIEW



Ground Level

With its entrance from S. River Road, the ground level includes the 3 Meeting Rooms, Exhibition Hall Level I, Arena Level I as well as access to loading docks, kitchen, Theatre basement and storage facilities.



Plaza Level

With its entrance from St. Louis Street, the plaza level includes the Theatre, two Ballrooms, 13 Meeting Rooms, The Pelican Room, The River View Room, Exhibition Hall Level II, Arena Level II and access to both the East and West Parking Garages.

Exhibition Hall Level I

- Total of approximately 70,000 sq. ft.
- Hall can be divided into two separate areas; 45,000 sq. ft. / 25,000 sq. ft.
- Pre-function lobby space totaling approximately 11,500 sq. ft.
- Uniform distribution load of 350 lbs. per sq. ft.
- Access to auxiliary box offices
- 2 escalators
- 2 patron elevators

Exhibition Hall Level II

- Thirteen (13) flexible meeting rooms ranging in size from 1,000 to 1,650 sq. ft. each
- Total meeting room space of approximately 18,800 sq. ft.
- Four (4) meeting rooms overlooking level I of the Exhibition Hall
- **Galleria** - Adjacent to meeting rooms, totals approximately 27,000 sq. ft. and serves as a functional space for meals, receptions, exhibits, registration, etc.
- **Riverview Room** - Interior function space totals approximately 3,100 sq. ft.; full view of Mississippi River and interior view of main lobby

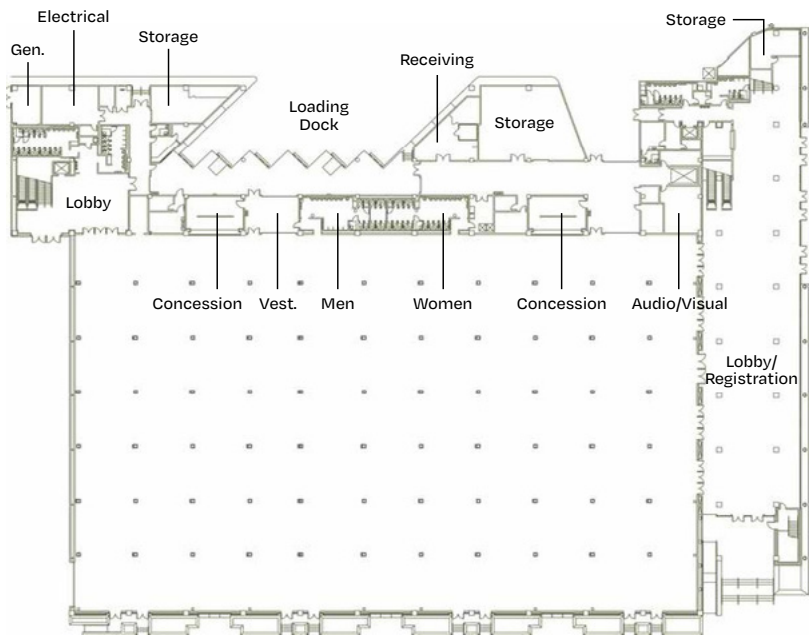
EXHIBITION HALL

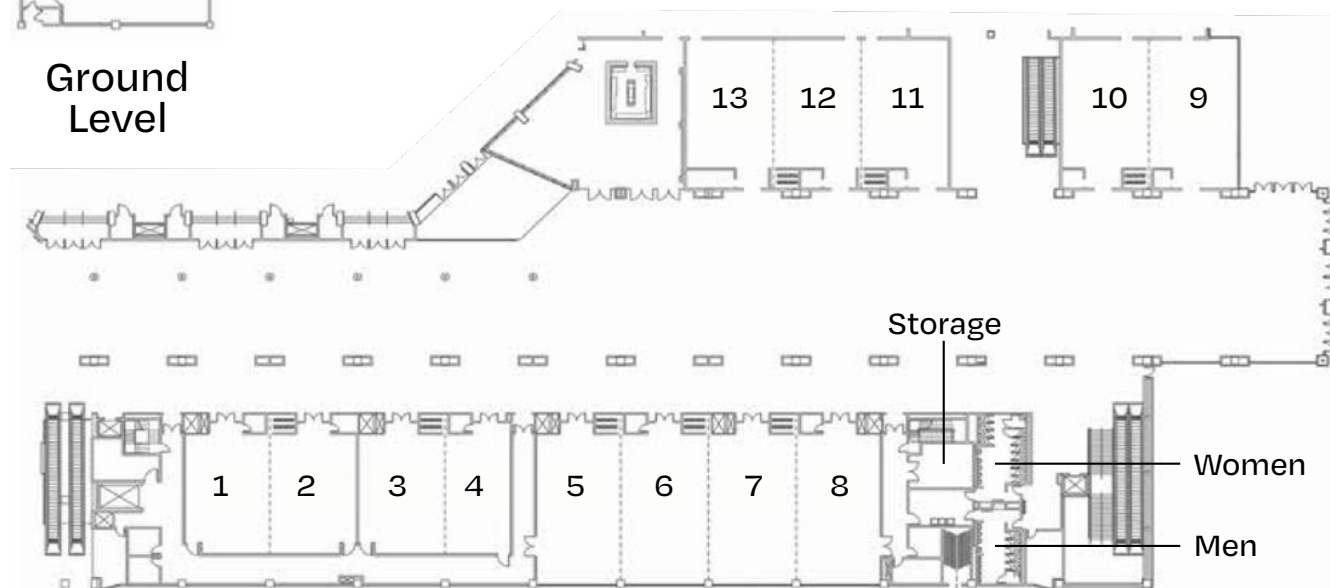
Exhibition Hall Level II

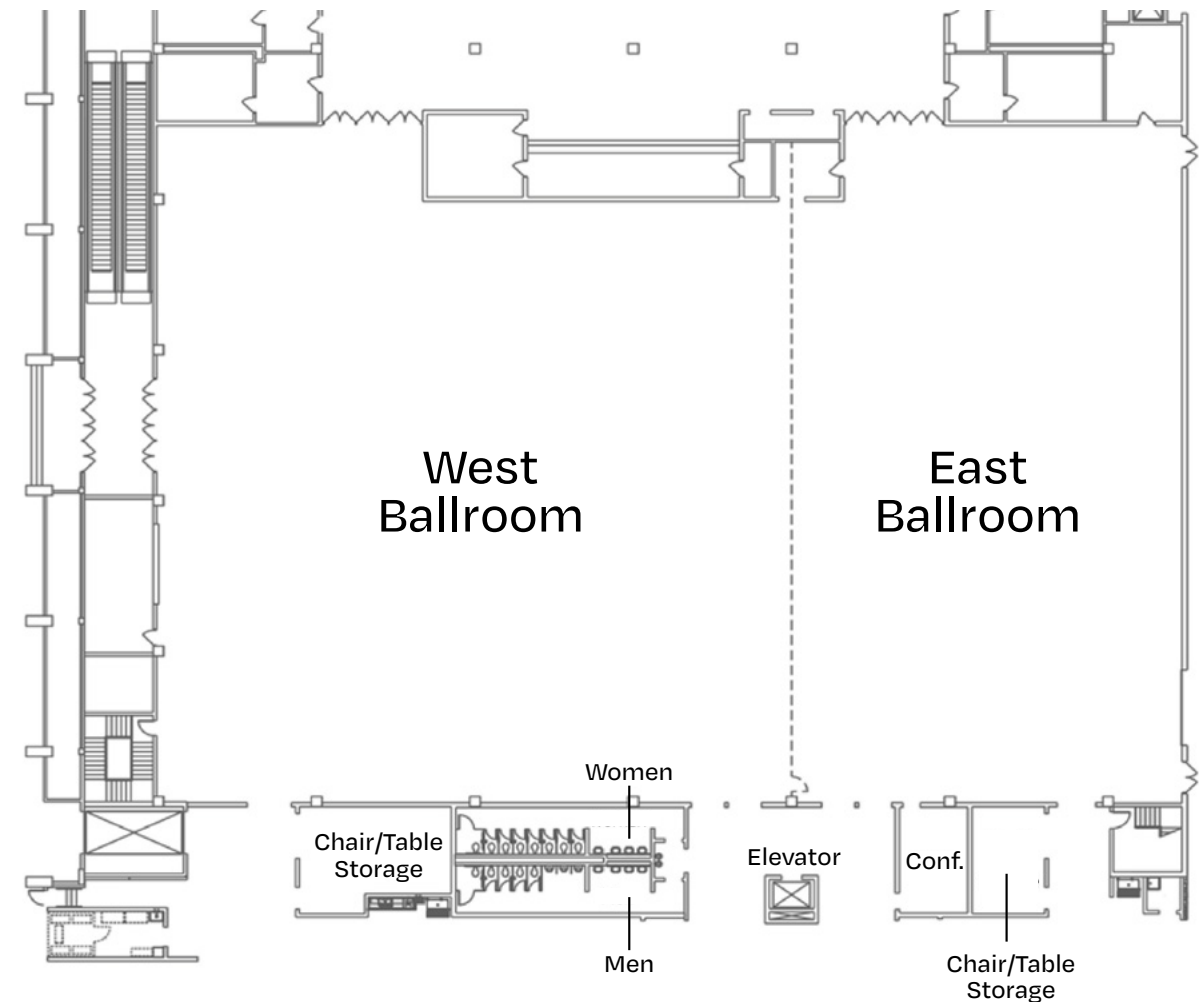

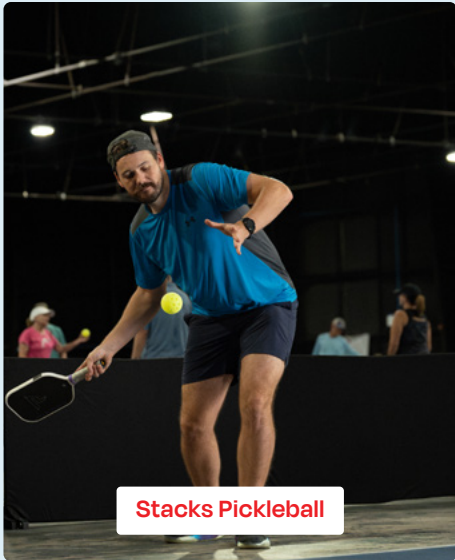
